Reader meets main character named Marcus Wright, an investigative skilled US TV station reporter, which is not a big star, more regular guy like you see every day one every TV station reporting from different places and due to different occasions. And when you will learn that Wright had been kidnapped by Palestinian terrorists, action will go back leading reader through the events that eventually made this tragic thing to happen. Wright was sent to Israel because of story when large group of US citizens were killed when terrorists attacked their tour bus. But this seasoned reporter found out that tourists were more than just innocent people visiting exotic country, while the bombing is just the start of something much bigger that jeopardize whole region. Daniel Reany, as already said, combined different elements in order to create exciting story; from religious motives, adventure similar to Indiana Jones to numerous history and cultural facts, reader is led by author through story all the time expecting what will happen next.
