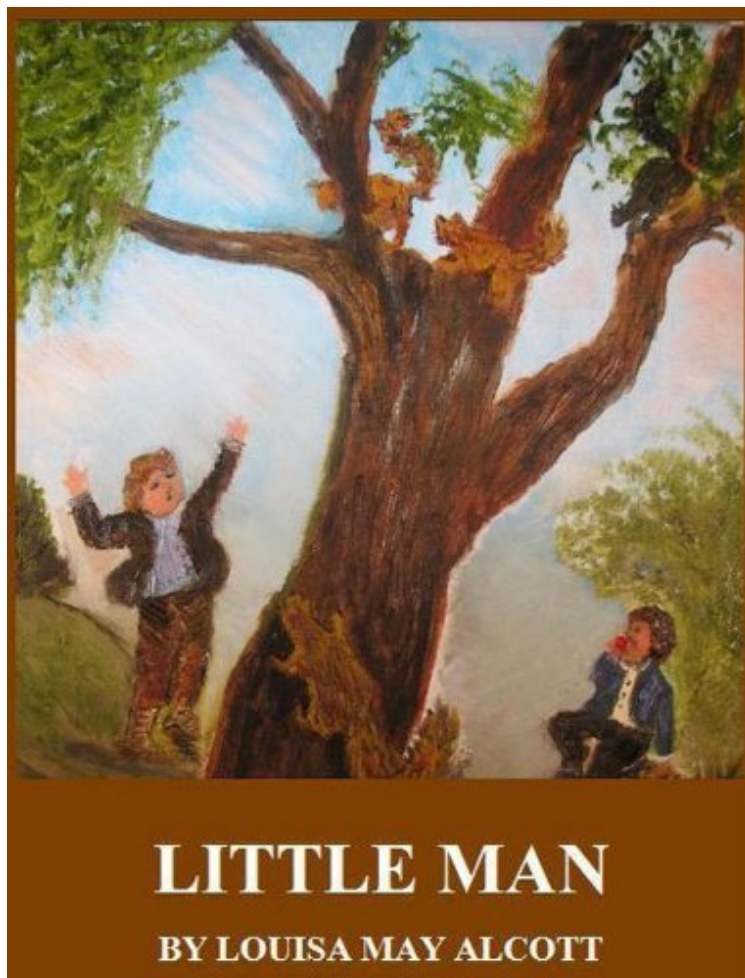

Es gibt beinahe keinen Abstand zum Blattrand, keine Seitenzahlen. Es finden sich oft Semikola ohne jeglichen Anlass. Eine hufig angewandte Art der Anführungszeichen wurde scheinbar durch "accents" ersetzt, was zu unnutig langen Wortabstnden fhrt und oft sind schlicht Wrter falsch gedruckt worden (so wird schon manchmal "the" statt "she" geschrieben...). The morals inside are more useful than any of the ten commandments. Louisa May Alcott has definitely done it again. Without giving away everything, these are some of the reasons why you will enjoy the book: 1) You see Jo grow up. She is no longer the wild child who's impetuous and androgynous character often lead her to trouble. She inherits maternal qualities that you never expected Jo to have. 2) You will get more insight on the professor. Although I truly wanted Teddy and Jo to get together, this book made me think otherwise. Professor Bhaer, with Jo's help, makes a delightful father to the boys.
