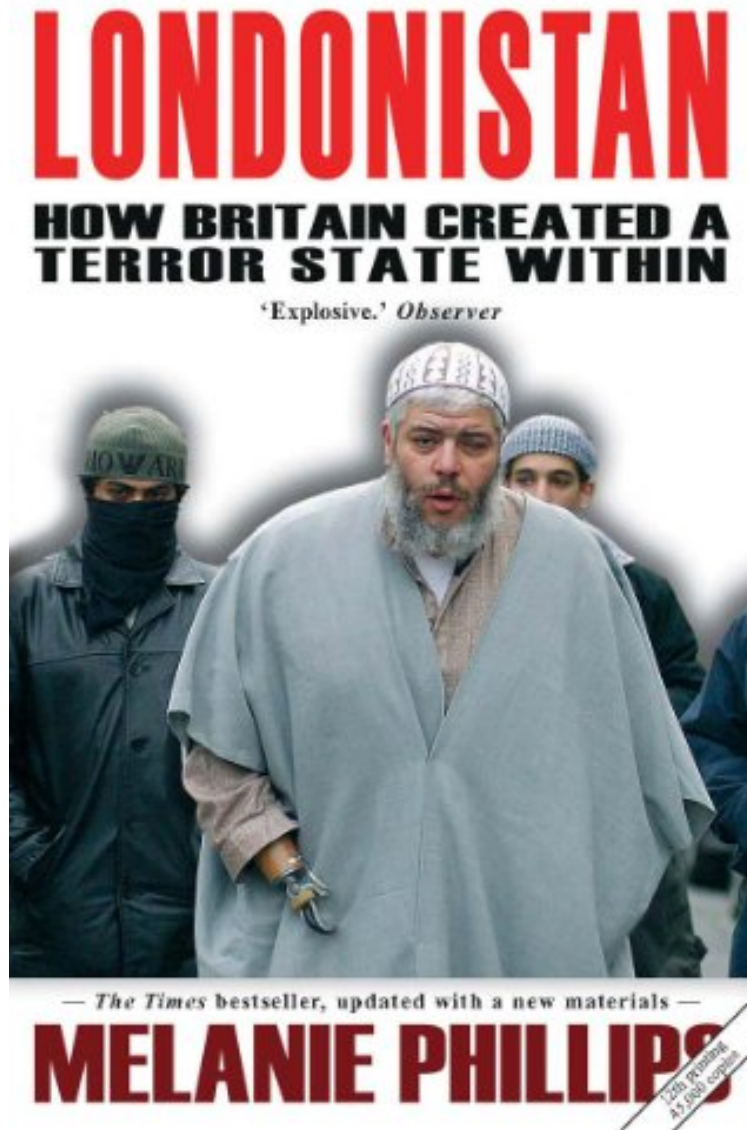

LondinistanVon FKPA's far as it goes, this book is good, in pointing out the real threat of Islam to the West. It exposes the shameful role of the Quisling Anglican Church in its mealy-mouthed compromise of the Gospel and kow-towing

to militant Islam. I would have given the book 5 stars, had the author not been so simplistic in her analysis. She is rightfully supportive of Israel as a people, but fails to see that enemy forces are also at work within Israeli politics, a fact which complicates the matter and confuses the majority of people into a stance of 'them and us'. The Talmud, like the Quran, also contains hate speech and words which would horrify Christians. The Talmud carries more weight with many Jews than the Tenach (Hebrew Bible/Old Testament) does. Within Israel, there is a strong lobby working to destroy from within, and this lobby has no interest in the faith of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, but is rather intent upon its own brand of New World Order, just as the Ahmadinedschads, Zbigniew Brzezinski, Maurice Strong, Rockefellers, Rothschilds and Javier Solanas, Hitlers etc of this world are or were, in their own way. That there is high level manipulation on all fronts, across the idealistic/religious/corporate/political/racial and national spectrum, makes it hard to understand what is happening. Those at the top of every pyramid of power, behind those in leadership, whether corporate, legislative, or religious, pull the strings of public leaders, many of whom may be sincere and good people. They, in their turn, propagandize the masses at the bottom of the pyramid via the media, into thinking that those in other pyramid systems, (religion, politics, gender or race) are their enemies. Fact is, the higher up the pyramid a person crawls, the closer he will be to those at the top of their own pyramids. In the end, all that matters to these monsters, regardless of which system they're in, is power and control. The enemy has always used this strategy; divide and rule. The author is correct in pointing out that the only hope for the West and Britain in particular, is a return to Biblical values. But this will only happen if Britain and the West wake up and make a 180 turn back to faith in Jesus Christ which we have largely jettisoned over the past 55 years. I do not mean outward religious church attendance or membership but an inward, spiritual relationship with Christ. This is a spiritual problem, and it can only be dealt with by spiritual means. Those brave souls who have left Islam for Jesus Christ (Isa al Masih) know only too well, to their cost, the price of following their Master, whether they live in Bradford or Baluchistan. The true church of Jesus Christ in Britain - not the public's idea of what the church is, but those who are real disciples, need to stand up and be counted and be prepared to lose their lives for their faith, just as used to be the case in Britain. If this book wakes some people up to the threat of Islam, good. Our reaction, however, should not be one of fear. Muslims are turning to faith in Jesus all over the world in huge numbers, which is why the foul spirit behind Islam is raging in its unwitting followers. We should be fearless in reaching out to them and telling them about the God who loves them and has provided a way for their sin and ours to be forgiven; something which every Muslim longs for and despairs of ever knowing. What else could fuel their madness, but the thought that if they just tried to please Allah that extra bit more, even by blowing themselves to bits, they might just attain their heavenly virgins? It chronicles the almost unnoticed surrender of Britain's values as it is faced with a radical fifth column in its midst. Phillips shows how the prevailing mood in the UK today is similar to the 1930s and demonstrates how multiculturalism, relativism, political correctness and the spirit of appeasement are crippling the once proud nation. The author backs up her claims with verifiable facts as she unmasks prominent personalities considered to be mainstream, like Iqbal Sacranie, secretary general of the Muslim Council of the UK. Propaganda from these sources has been granted legitimacy by the establishment. Even the British police suffer from the disease of political correctness while society in general does not want to know that a civilizational struggle is looming. Having encouraged the notion of victim culture, the British state is partly responsible for the moral inversion that takes place after acts of terrorism. The communities from which it emanates immediately claim victim status. Even more disconcerting is the fact that Leftists have rallied to the Islamist cause. The author calls this the red-black alliance, and it is also thoroughly explored, in the US context, in the book *Unholy Alliance* by David Horowitz. Thus the British media and intellectual elites, in a pathological display of denial, blame the victims Israel and the USA for the very existence of Islamic terrorism. Anti-Semitism in the Muslim world is ignored whilst the Left itself is becoming bolder in embracing this mental virus. The distinction between criticism of Israeli actions and blatant anti-Semitism is becoming blurry, with many a line having been crossed in the leftist media. Propagandistic reporting from the Middle East is increasing and whilst some of it has been exposed by intrepid bloggers, the attitude has become entrenched in media like for example the BBC, The Guardian and The Independent. Phillips proposes some remedies for the perils facing the UK, such as stricter immigration controls, the monitoring of clerics and organizations that propagate violence, and the abandonment of multiculturalism for a return to British values. Time will tell if the UK has the mettle to meet the challenges but no one will be able to say that the country hasn't been warned. The same goes for the West as a whole: Phillips is one of many voices raising the alarm. One can only pray that the warnings will be heeded. The hour is late.
