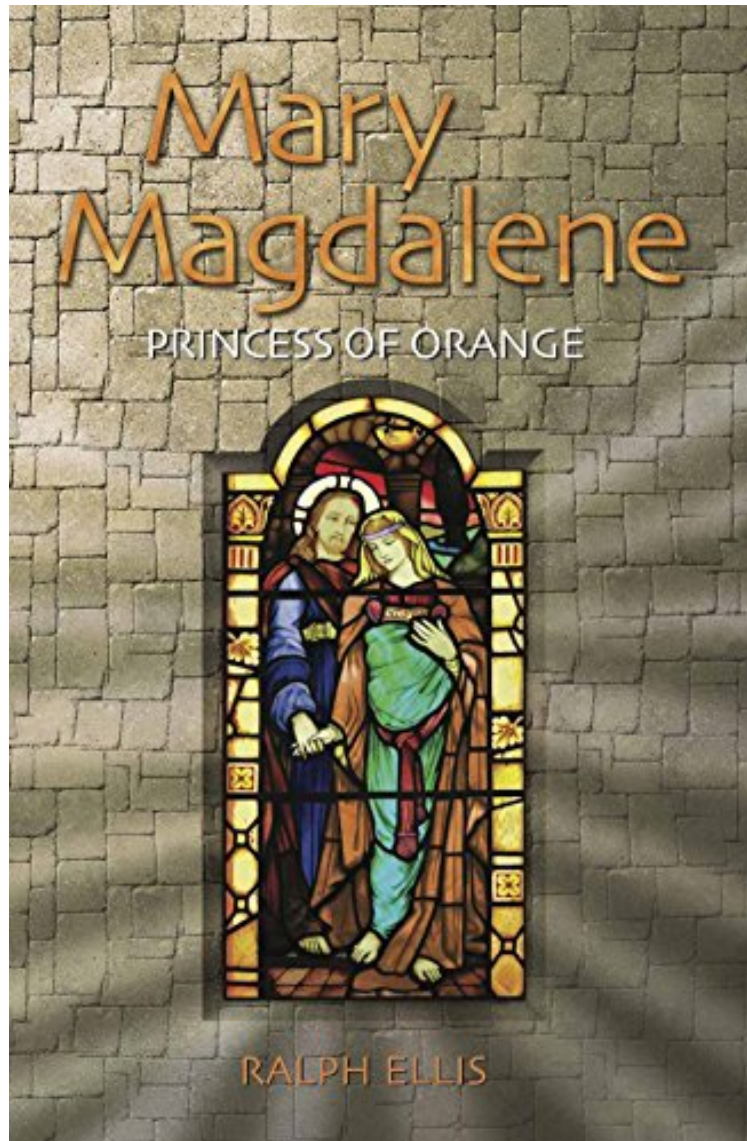

Jesus figure as a Syrian king who fought but lost against Rome and then was exiled - addresses the fate of Jesus' sister-wife Mary Magdalene and her offspring after their flight to southern France. I do not consider this a proven case, but excellent food for thought which requires additional research. I'm subtracting a point because the second half of the book (so I felt) is a cultural-political rant which should have gone into a separate text as it is not really connected to this book's topic. But ok, one could just ignore that part, or read it separately. I do recommend this book, but it is probably necessary to read Ellis' earlier books on this topic before to be able to follow his argument, at least "King Jesus" but better "Cleopatra to Christ" first. This book only provides one (minor) piece to this puzzle. The Kindle formatting is obviously less than optimal, ok for reading the text but make sure to use "Kindle for PC" too to check out the pictures in color and full size.
