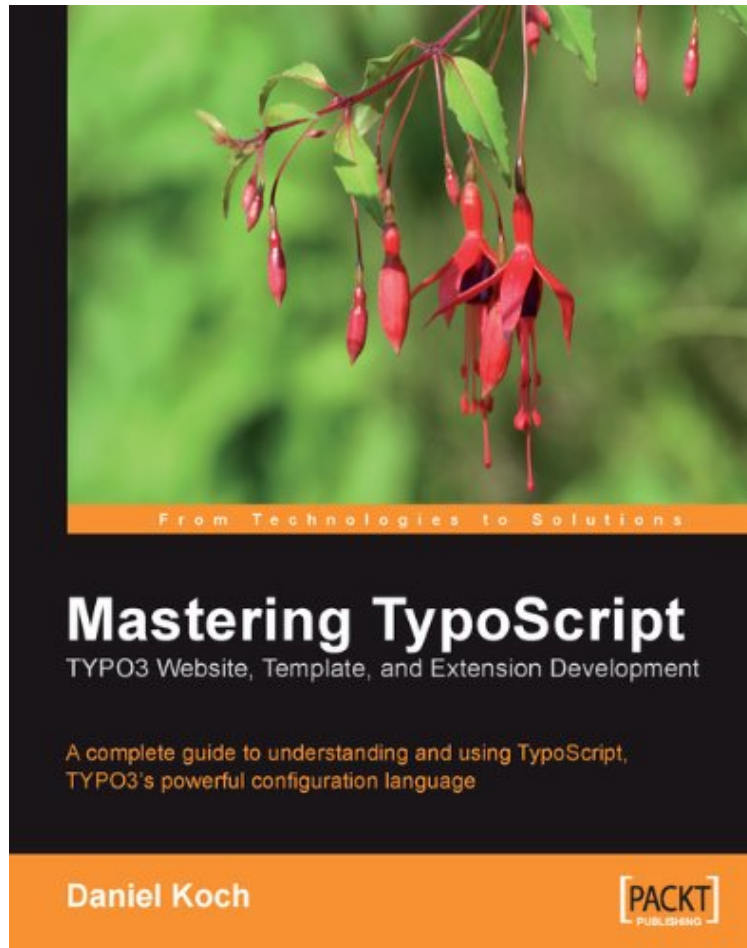

Started not to bad but very disappointing endVon Ronald[english text because the book is in english]Although the book started off pretty promising, in the end it left me quite disappointed.The first 6 chapters are not too bad and explain quite a lot on the general concepts of TypoScript. After this the quality drops. These chapters contain lot's of examples but none of these come with any explanation of with the keypoint of the example is. Even a little image of the result of the example in a browser is missing.Furthermore the examples contain too much whitespaces (thus breaking the code), have too many }-signs (again breaking the code) or are not indented correctly (making them hard to read). The text is

not always well structured and well written. It really like nobody ever did a re-read of the print before publishing. Nowhere is this book it explains how to insert the Typo3-content (as stored in your database) into your html-template (using `styles.content.get`). Isn't that what a cms is all about? And the Typoscript-'reference' in the end of the book is far from complete. What good is this for a reference? In fact the author refers to the online ts-reference (which is far from correct or complete either).
