 Fallschirmjgerdivisionen an der Oderfront) wird allerdings erkennbar, dass Eismann seine Niederschrift weitgehend
oder vllig aus dem Gedchtnis gettigt haben muss. Die bersetzung ist in vieler Hinsicht ungenau; oft ist nicht erkennbar,
ob sachliche Fehler dem bersetzer oder dem Autor zuzurechnen sind. Die Fhigkeiten und Leistungen des
Generalobersten Heinrici als Truppenfhrer werden stark beschnigt. Falls jemals das Kriegstagebuch seiner
Heeresgruppe oder Briefe aus seinem Nachlass verffentlicht werden sollten, wird sich dieses verflschte Bild
