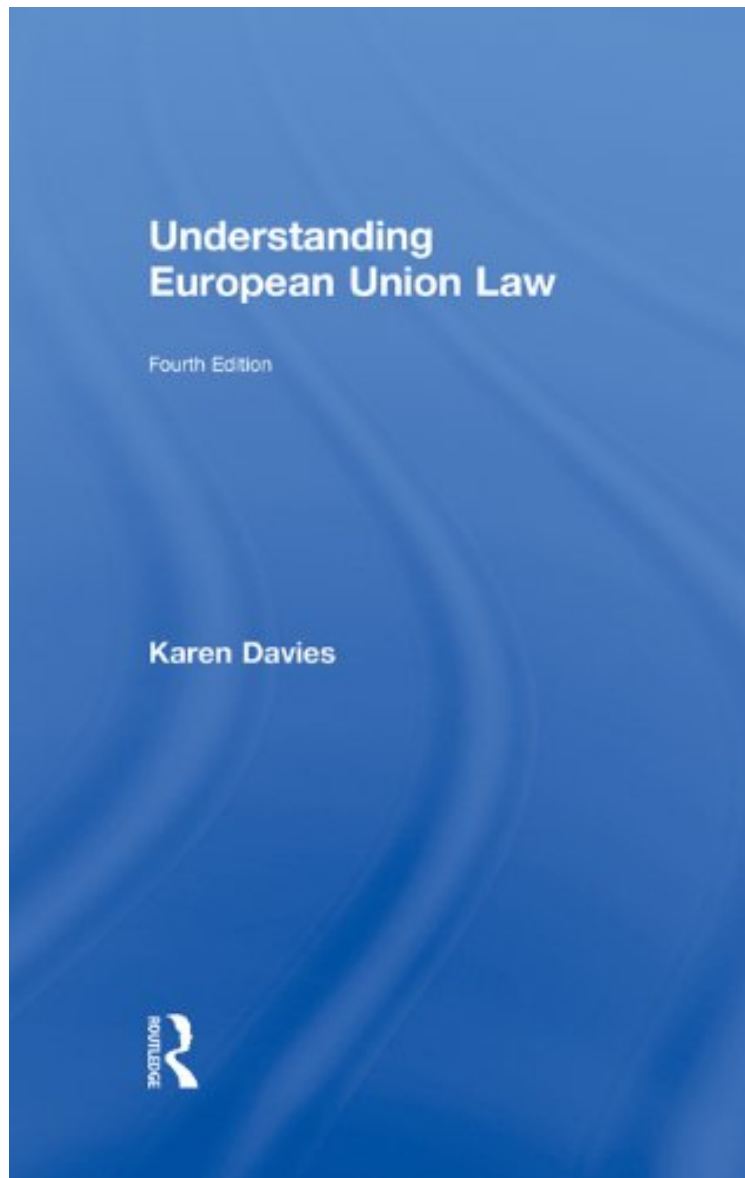

Klugerweise wird hier das Glossar nicht wie blich in den Anhang verbannt, sondern dem eigentlichen Text vorangestellt. So werden zusammen mit einer Auflistung der gebruchlichsten Abkürzungen die wichtigsten Begriffe für den Leser vorab geklärt. Es ist zwar in erster Linie für das Studium gedacht, kann aber aufgrund der verständlichen Erklärungen auch jedem interessierten Laien empfohlen werden.
